

Conestoga Valley Youth Softball SCHOLARSHIP

The 2021 Conestoga Valley Youth Softball Board desired to develop a scholarship program that would help former players obtain post-graduate education. CVYS funds its scholarship program through funds earmarked for CVYS scholarships, late fees and new donations received annually, and any surplus funds from the program's general operating fund. Every year, applications are reviewed, selected and awarded a \$500 scholarship for the first year of their post graduate program.

There is no relationship between the award of a scholarship and athletic ability. Each scholarship recipient is notified of their award in a congratulatory letter. Each awardee is requested to return a scholarship acceptance letter confirming the spelling of their name, provide a picture suitable for publication and confirm the school/program of choice.

By accepting this scholarship, the applicant agrees, in good faith, that these funds will be used for tuition, books, room & board, school equipment, or school supplies. If an applicant does not remain enrolled at the school, the unused portion shall be returned to CVYS.

Who Should Apply? Outstanding *CV High School Senior softball players* who have participated in both the CVYS (formerly known as CVYAA) program and CVHS softball program for a minimum of 3 years and plan to pursue post-graduate education. The minimum acceptable credentials include High School GPA 3.0, evidence of strong school and community leadership, letter of recommendation from a teacher or coach, completed essay and is in good standing with the CVHS softball program.

What is the Deadline? The 2025 deadline for submitting completed scholarship applications is April 25th. Hand your completed application packet to CVYS Board Members OR email it to cvyouthsoftball@gmail.com.

Applications will be taken from January 1st thru April 1st each year. The winners will be selected by May 1st. (Deadline extended to April 25th for 2025)

What is the application process?

1. Fill out the application form, sign and submit to the CVYS before the deadline date.
2. Include a letter of recommendation. The letter should come from an individual who has a good knowledge of your achievements and potential.
3. Include proof/statement of participation in CVYS including the applicant's years of participation and coach name(s).
4. Include a copy of your latest High School transcript.
5. Include a personal essay. It should be 150 words or less, typed or handwritten and signed. Address the question: How has youth and high school softball shaped your life? The essay provides a way in which to become better acquainted with you.
6. Provide acceptance letter(s) to post-graduate program(s).
7. Submit one picture—cap & gown, or other formal wear preferred. And Submit a picture from when you played for CVYS

- ☐ Provide one graduation photo (cap and gown or formal) and one CVYS photo (if able)
